On l'utilise pour exprimer:

- l'intention: ce que l'on a l'intention de faire, ce que l'on a prévu, déjà planifié

John is going to play tennis.

(Il a l'intention d'aller jouer au tennis)

- la prévision:

Tim is going to be in trouble

(Tim va avoir des ennuis)

It's going to rain.

(Il va pleuvoir)

Il s'utilise souvent sans marqueur temps

FUTUR SIMPLE	FUTUR D'INTENTION
I will + BV	I am going to + BV
you will +BV	You are going to + BV
he/she/it will + BV	he/she/it is going to +BV
We will + BV	we are going to + BV
You will + BV	you are going to + BV
they will + BV	they are going to + BV
