WILL	
I will + BV	I won't
You will	You won't
He/she/it will	She won't
We will	We won't
You will	You won't
They will	They won't

WOULD	
I would	I wouldn't
You would	You wouldn't
He/she/it would	He wouldn't
We would	We wouldn't
You would	You wouldn't
They would	They wouldn't

WILL est l'auxiliaire du FUTUR.

WOULD exprime le CONDITIONNEL.

SHOULD	
I should	I shouldn't
You should	You shouldn't
He/she/it should	She shouldn't
We should	We shouldn't
You should	You shouldn't
They should	They shouldn't

COULD	
I could	I couldn't
You could	You couldn't
He/she/it could	He couldn't
We could	We couldn't
You could	You couldn't
They could	They couldn't
